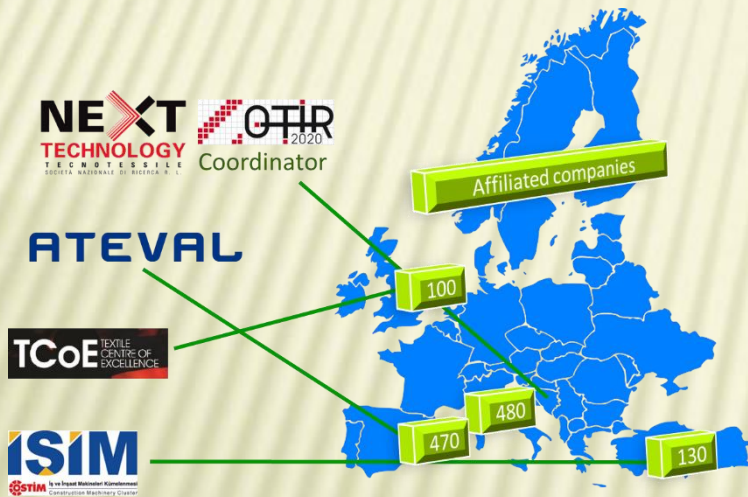
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Objectives

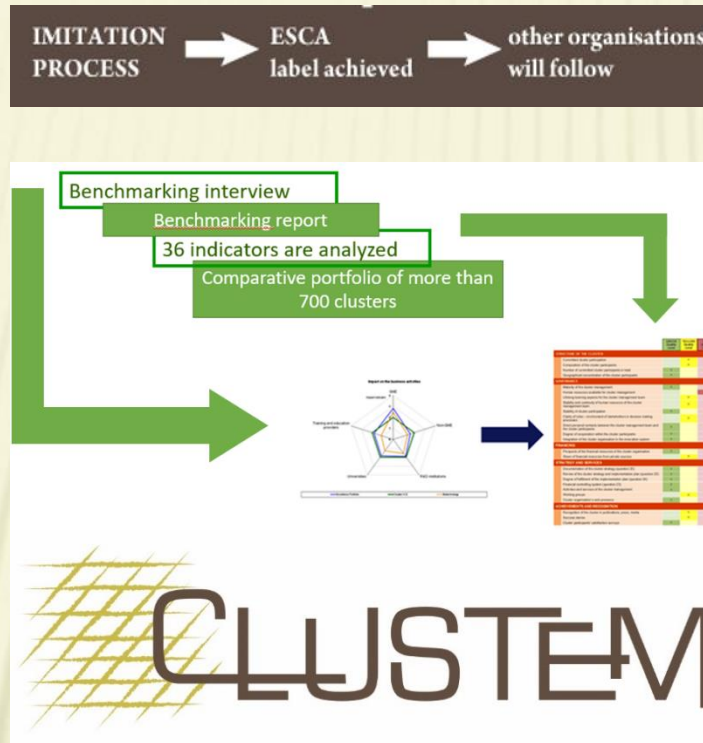
The project, based on the results of European Cluster Excellency Initiative (ECEI), aim to increase Clusters competencies in management and services along the associated SMEs, namely:
